

KIRMINGTON & CROXTON PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on Tuesday 10th January, 2023 at 7:30pm at Hampton by Hilton Hotel Conference Room, Humberside Airport, Kirmington.

Prior to the commencement of the meeting Members stood for one minute silence to remember Mr. Nev Page; a former respected member of the Parish Council who sadly passed away on 16th December, 2022.

01.01.23- To note Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr T Walton, Cllr A Hannigan and NLC Ward Cllr P Clark.

02.01.23- Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr T Marsden declared an interest on any item regarding highway issues on the C137, as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr D Wells declared a personal interest on any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council & Ernllca, as he is a Representative.

Cllr W Turner declared a personal interest on any item on the agenda in connection with Kirmington Church, as he is a Representative.
