

## KIRMINGTON & CROXTON PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 at 7:15pm following the Annual Parish Meeting at Hampton by Hilton Hotel Conference Room, Humberside Airport, Grimsby Road, Kirmington, DN39 6YH.

Present - Cllr T Marsden, Cllr S Taylor, Cllr R Hannigan, Cllr A Hannigan, Cllr D Wells & Cllr W Turner.

Cllr S Taylor remarked how the Parish Council were glad to see Cllr T Marsden well and present.

01.04.24 - To note Apologies for Absence.

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr R Wheeler, Cllr T Walton & NLC Ward Cllr Peter Clark.

02.04.24- Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register.

Cllr D Wells declared a personal interest in any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council & Ernllca, as he is a Representative.

Cllr T Marsden declared an interest in any item regarding highway issues on the C137, as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr W Turner declared a personal interest in any item in connection with the Church; as he is a Representative.

Cllr S Taylor declared an interest in any item on the agenda in connection with parking issues at the Marrowbone & Cleaver.

03.04.24 - To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

The Parish Council considered the minutes dated 19.03.24. **Resolution - The Parish Council confirmed the minutes dated 19.03.2024 were a true and accurate record.**

04.04.24 - Public Participation.

None.

05.04.24- To receive the Chairman's Report - an update on decisions taken at previous meetings.

All items are on the agenda.

06.04.24 - To receive an update from the Airport Consultative Committee and Noise Monitoring

Cllr T Marsden hopes to be able to attend the next ACC meeting. Cllr S Taylor offered to attend if he cannot.

Cllr T Marsden expressed concerns over the lack of noise monitoring figures online for aircraft movements since January 2024. Cllr D Wells has requested NLC Environmental Team investigate.

07.04.24 - To receive any updates from NATS and discuss any items to be raised at the next NATS meeting and any further Police Matters and any updates on Country & Wildlife Crime.

Cllr D Wells attended the latest NATS meeting and no concerns affecting Kirmington & Croxton raised at present.

Cllr R Hannigan has a meeting soon with the new Barton Police Inspector and will raise with him the lack of enforcement on the C137.

08.04.24 - To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action.

Cllr R Hannigan reported there will be funding available for a public electric charging point in the village from NLC. Cllr S Taylor expressed concerns regarding the placement, type of charger and cable issues.

09.04.24 -(a) To consider any further Highways matters within the Parish for the Clerk to take up with North Lincolnshire Council.

Cllr T Marsden reported 2 further accidents at the crossroads and flooding issues recently. Cllr R Hannigan advised the drain issue has now been completed and advised NLC will not support the speed limit reduction request on the A18 as the police do not recommend it. NLC are going to come back to him with an alternative scheme. Cllr S Taylor suggested a countdown to the junction sign from the northbound C137 to the A18 in order to slow traffic down. Cllr T Marsden advised the number of HGV's breaking the weight limit on the C137 is increasing.

Cllr R Hannigan has asked Gareth Denovan at NLC for rental information.

Cllr R Hannigan will collect and fit the signage shortly.

Cllr R Hannigan has agreed with NLC for aggregate to be delivered and will then recruit volunteers to lay.

Cllr R Hannigan suggested to concentrate on 1 bus stop at present along Kirmington High Street and will supply further information once received from NLC. Cllr S Taylor queried the location. NLC have advised the Croxton bus shelter cannot be sited at the previous site and are considering an alternative location for the future.

Kit Read from the Brocklesby Estate has requested to be kept up to date with any bus shelter proposals in Croxton. Cllr R Hannigan agreed to liaise with him regarding both bus shelter proposals.

Cllr S Taylor provided an update submitted from Cllr R Wheeler. The Parish Council agreed they need to assist Cllr R Wheeler and form a working committee. Cllr R Hannigan, Cllr A Hannigan, Cllr S Taylor to arrange with Cllr R Wheeler. Cllr T Marsden agreed to donate £50 from the Chairman's Allowance towards the event.
