### 03.04.2025a - Chairpersons Report and Wish List

**Playing Field** - This is still being very well used. Thanks to Trevor Walton for his efforts in maintaining the area. Thanks also to John Fisk, Ian Martin and Malcolm Taylor in their efforts too in keeping the villages looking great. I would like to increase the use of the playing field further over the coming years.

**Airport** - The airport seems to be running well. I would like to continue the Remembrance Memorial Event at the Airport as part of the Remembrance Day Service.

**Singleton and Birch** - The Parish Council to continue to monitor the situation with the road and chalk conditions.

**Church Light up at Christmas & Service** - The Church was lit up again over the Christmas and New Year period and I hope this will continue.

**New Housing** - The Parish Council will continue to monitor any planning

applications as the village boundaries should be protected.

**Bowls Club** - Continue to monitor for any updates.

**166 Squadron Memorial Service** - The Parish Council will continue to attend the event each September and lay a wreath.

**Remembrance Day** - The service was well attended and will continue the same format.

**166 Squadron Commemorative Stone** - The Remembrance Day event will continue at the Stone and the Brocklesby Church.

**Road Safety** - The new bus shelter has been installed in Kirmington. The flashing speed sign is due to be installed shortly. North Lincolnshire Council due to carry out the full speed limit review of the A18 during Autumn 2025 to look at reducing the speed limit.

### **Year 2025/2026**

The Parish Council will continue to support the villages within the Government guidelines and Road Map.

The main projects for the new financial year will be :-

- Continue with the grass cutting around the villages
- The maintenance of the Playing Field
- The signed lease for the Playing Field
- Apply for the Spring in Bloom Grant for floral displays in the villages

- Arrange the Remembrance Day Service at the War Memorial and the 166 Squadron Memorial Stone at the Airport and Brocklesby Church
- To apply for grant funding for Croxton Bus Shelter
